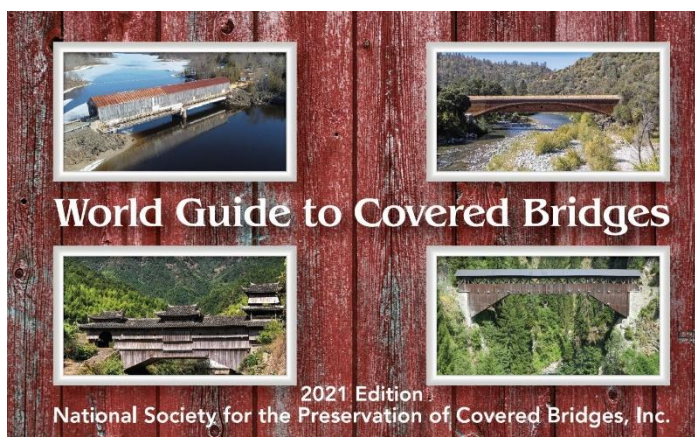

Page 2, Cullman County, revised directions, corrections to number of spans and construction date (updated February 11, 2022)

AL/01-22-01 Clarkson Crooked Creek Clarkson or Legg **4** 250' **1922** Modified Town
6.8 miles west of jct I-65 (exit 308) on US278/AL74, then 0.6 miles right on Bethel Battleground Rd.
(CR1117) and left 0.6 miles on CR1043 to the bridge on the right side of the road. Closed. (NR) N34°
12.47' W086° 59.47'

California

Page 4, Stanislaus County, correct length (added October 22, 2021)

CA/05-50-01 Knight's Ferry Stanislaus River Knight's Ferry 3+ **379'** 1864 Howe

Page 3, Nevada County, revised directions (added October 28, 2021)

CA/05-29-01 Nevada City South Fork Yuba River Bridgeport 1 226'-4" 1862 Howe & Arch
7.6 miles northwest of jct CA49 on CA20, then 7.7 miles right on Pleasant Valley Rd. and left into the
parking lot of South Yuba State Park. Closed. Restored 2021. (NR) N39° 17.570' W121° 11.696'

Georgia

Page 7, Cobb County, update the construction date (added February 2, 2022)

GA/10-33-02 Concord or Ruffs Mill or Nickajack Creek Bridge Nickajack Creek 2 132' **1891** Modified Queen

Page 8, DeKalb County, GA/10-44-01 in Stone Mountain Park has been officially renamed the **Washington W. King or College Avenue Bridge**. (added September 20, 2022)

Indiana

Page 21, Parke County, the directions for the Big Rocky Fork or Murphy Bridge, IN/14-61-01, mention CR7205, it should be **CR720S**. (added November 16, 2021)

Michigan

Page 40, Kent County, the Ada or Bradfield Bridge, MI/22-41-01#2, update the truss type to **Brown**. (added April 27, 2022)

New Hampshire

Page 51, Merrimack County, New Hampshire, update the construction date for the Waterloo Station Bridge, NH/29-07-04, to **1860**. (added December 31, 2023)

New York

Page 59, Ulster County, New York, update the number for Perrine's Bridge to **NY/32-56-01#2**. Ron Knapp's research has discovered that a bridge was built at this location in 1821 and covered in 1822. (added October 27, 2022)

Page 60, Ulster County, coordinates for the Ashokan or Turnwood Bridge, NY/32-56-05, did not print correctly. They should be N41° 55.596' W074° 11.937' (added June 24, 2022)

Page 60, Add the Cannon Bridge in Wyoming County (added June 17, 2022)

NY/32-61-07#2 Bennington Cayuga Creek Cannon 1 2022 Pratt Variant
2.9 miles west of jct with NY77 at Bennington on NY354, then 0.8 miles left on Folsomdale Rd (County route 35), then 0.7 miles ahead on Schoellkopf Rd. N42° 49.114' W078° 26.749'

Ohio

Page 75, Holmes County, add the Spellacy Bridge (added August 29, 2023)

OH/35-38-05 Knox Mohican River Spellacy 2 300' 2023 Modified Pratt
0.4 miles south of Main St. in Loudonville on OH3 (S. Market St.), then 2.9 miles left on CR529 (becomes CR230), then 0.3 miles left on CR23. N40° 35.645' W082° 12.419'

Page 79, Morgan County, the Barkhurst Mill or Williams Bridge, OH/35-58-15, is no longer closed. (added April 8, 2022)

Pennsylvania

Page 135, Washington County, correct coordinates of the Pine Bank Bridge, PA/38-63-35, to **N40° 17.290' W080° 29.418'** (added January 29, 2023)

Vermont

Page 139, Caledonia County, update directions of the Greenbanks Hollow Bridge, VT/45-03-01#2 (added October 24, 2023)

6.9 miles west of I-91 exit 21 on US2 to Danville, then first left onto Park St (becomes Brainerd St) for 0.8 miles, then 1.9 miles ahead (paved road curves left) onto Greenbanks Hollow Rd. South-southeast of Danville. Rebuilt in 2002. Clearance: 11'-6". N44° 22.652' W072° 07.322'

Page 139, Caledonia County, the Sanborn of Centre Bridge, VT/45-03-05, is no longer privately-owned. It has been purchased by the town of Lyndon. (added February 11, 2022)

Page 146, Orange County, coordinates for the Cilley or Lower Bridge (VT/45-09-08) should be corrected to **N43° 52.978' W072° 30.233'** (added June 28, 2022)

Page 146, Orange County, coordinates for the Flint Bridge (VT/45-09-11) should be corrected to **N43° 56.960' W072° 27.516'** (added June 28, 2022)

British Columbia, Canada

Page 163, Columbia-Shuswap Region, British Columbia (added February 2, 2023)

Add directions for the Kicking Horse Pedestrian Bridge, BC/52-08-02, in Golden

0.45 miles north of jct 10th Ave. S. (Highway 95) and 12th St. S. in Golden, then left on 9th Ave. N. and next left into a parking area. Park and walk to the bridge. Add directions: 0.45 miles north of jct 10th Ave.

1.5 miles (2.4 km) west of NB111 on Main Village Rd., then 0.1 miles (0.2 km) right on Shore Rd. N45°

Page 172, Victoria County, correct the name of NB/55-13-03 to **Tomlinson Mill or Odellach River #2**. (added August 6, 2022)

Québec

Page 180, Cantons de l'Est, Québec, QC/61-11-02 (added September 12, 2023)

The name of this bridge has been officially changed from Pont Decelles to **Pont Decelles-Fortin**.

China

Page 283, P'ingnan County, Fujian Province, delete the Wan'an Bridge which was lost to a fire on August 6, 2022. (added August 7, 2022)

Estonia

Page 210, Add the Järuska Bridge in Ida-Viru County (added March 12, 2022)

EE-03-01 Lemmaku Rannapungerja jõgi Järuska 1 26.4m, 119' 2013 Town
In the village of Lemmaku northeast of rte. 88 N59° 00.751' E027° 08.279'

Germany

Page 215, update directions and add coordinates. (added February 2, 2023)

DE-01-40 Göppingen Fils River 1 23m, 74' 1925 inverted Multiple King
At Göppingen between Metzgerstraße and Nikolaus-Lenau-Straße, southwest of Route 297
(Stuttgarterstraße). N48° 42.249' E009° 38.403'

Page 216, Baden-Württemberg, Germany, add name, truss and construction date. (added February 2, 2023)

DE-01-52 Bonndorf im Schwarz- Wutach River **Kanadiersteg** 1 19m, 61' **1976 low Multiple King**

Page 217, Baden-Württemberg, Germany, correct coordinates, add truss type. (added February 2, 2023)

DE-01-58 Kohlwald **Multiple King N47° 54.096', E008° 17.472'**

Page 218, Baden-Württemberg, Germany, delete DE-01-65, bridge burned April 21, 2021. (added February 2, 2023)

Page 219, Baden-Württemberg, Germany, correct river name and add details to DE-01-73 (added February 2, 2023)

DE-01-73 Donaueschingen **Brigach River, railroad and road Siedlersteg** 4 **83m, 272'** 1987
inverted Multiple King?

Page 220, Baden-Württemberg, Germany, change river name of DE-01-79 to **Lein River**. (added February 2, 2023)

Page 227, Bayern (Bavaria), correct river name and add details to DE-02-36. (added February 2, 2023)

DE-02-36 Bayreuth Mistel Brook 1 35m, 114' 1984

Page 227, Bayern (Bavaria), update river name of DE-02-39 to **Eittinger Fehlbach (Saubach) River**. (added February 2, 2023)

Italy

Page 236, Trentino-Alto Adige/Südtirol Region, South Tyrol, update coordinates of IT-17-01-13 to **N46° 48.819' E011° 42.660'** (added February 18, 2023)

Norway

Page 237, add two previously unlisted bridges in Innlandet County, Norway. (added January 10, 2024)

Note: These two bridges are not being assigned World Guide numbers at this time. Our normal pattern is to use the two letter country code, followed by a number representing the first level administrative subdivision, in this case counties, and then a sequential number for each bridge in that county. Norway has reorganized its counties twice in the past four years. Due to this instability, we will not assign numbers yet.

Lillehammer Mansa River Finna 1 27.6m, 88.6' 1868 (M1934) Howe

From the Lillehammer train station for 400m, then 230m right on Tomtegata, then 800m right on Nordsetervegen, then 600m right on Sigrid Undsets veg then 190m left on Birkebeinervegen, then walk 60m south. N61° 07.150' E010° 28.661'

Dokka Dokka River Skolmen 1 41m, 134.5' 2021 Howe

950m north of jct Route 33 on Route 250, then 2nd exit of roundabout to remain on Route 250 for 400m, then 4.1 km right on Route 250 (Lillehammervegen), then 900m left on a gravel drive, then bear left at fork onto a trail for 350m to the bridge site. N60° 53.099' E010° 02.428'

Slovakia

Page 238, Košice Region of Slovakia, note updates to SK-02-01. (added February 18, 2023)

SK-02-01 Kluknava Hornád River **Štefanská Huta** 31m, 105' 1831 Queen

1.9 km east of jct 3420 on 547 (near Kluknava), then 450 m left on 3280, then 150 m left on unnamed road. N48° 54.994' E020° 57.115'

Follow Route 4 east from Oberlangenegg for 5.0 km to junction with Göscher Str. Follow Göscher Str. for 380 m to bridge. N46° 49.435' E007° 46.117'

Page 257, canton of Berne, add CH-06-121 (added February 20, 2023)

CH-06-121 Schwarzenburg / Rüeggisberg Schwarzwasser Steiglenau 1 27m, 88' 2014 Pratt

On a hiking trail in Gantrisch Nature Park. The ½ mile long trail winds through a steep gorge between two roads, Steiglen on the Rüeggisberg side and Buttningenbad on the Schwarzenburg side. N46° 50.133', E007° 22.471'

Page 257, Canton of Berne, Switzerland, add CH-06-122 (added May 20, 2023)

Schangnau Emme River Chaltbach 1866 Multiple King
N46° 48.687' E007° 54.450'

Zweisimme Simme River Velo 1 27.5m, 90' Howe
5.3 km north of Zweisimmen on route 11. N46° 35.751' E007° 22.536'

Page 257, Canton of Berne, Switzerland, add CH-06-125 (added May 20, 2023)

Rüeggisberg –Oberbalm Bütschelbach Bütschelbach 1999 1 20.4m, 67' Queen
On a hiking trail about 145m from the mouth of Bütschelbach River. N46° 51.119' E007° 23.516'

Page 257, Canton of Berne, Switzerland, add CH-06-126 (added May 20, 2023)

Kemmeribodenbad Emme River Kemmeriboden 2009 1 28.7m, 94' Arch
Head east from Schangnau for 1.8km, then bear left at fork on Egghüttli for 5.6km to bridge at
Kemmeriboden. N46° 48.161', E007° 56.099'

Page 267, canton of St. Gallen, correct coordinates of CH-15-24 to **N46° 56.983' E009° 29.087'** (added February 18, 2023)
